Other Comments:

- Keep TTT but also continue to support the ITT as a way to address participation for athletes from smaller schools.
- Need to have a conference championship for these events so that schools and riders can be properly staged and qualified for Nationals.
- Must have a 2-week gap between last conference race and nationals. Nationals date being published early Is key to teams establishing their won events.
- USAC needs to bring back the Omnium title and Jersey plus medals at Nationals
- RMCCC should waive the notion of physical awards and invest any monies into the conference and riders.

- Fees are excessive and stymying participation from students and taxing both varsity and club team budget. What do all these fees cover? Can they be reduced?

- Club team riders pay their own way to events, day pass costs are going up at \$64-\$80 per day. Resort fees are also going up and are now above \$30 per rider/day.
- MTB Event at Cuchara?
 - Resort fees are going up everywhere
 - No lift services but great potential
 - Need sponsoring school or organization
 - Non-Profit status and looking to build a future for sporting events
 - Some past venues are declining to host for 2024
 - CU is looking to find a smaller venue with lower costs and easier access
 - How can RMCCC step up and support the MTB season? New venues, alternative venues?
