 Collegiate Entry Fee- \$10 for TTT, \$35 each for Criterium/Road Race. USAC Collegiate license required. \$5 fee for race day reg!
- USAC Entry Fee- \$20 for ITT, \$40 each for Criterium/Road Race. \$5 fee for race day reg! USAC License Required. USAC 1-Day Beginner license: \$15, only for Cat 5 men Cat 5 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. Former USAC cat 1,2,3,4 members can purchase 1-day Experience licenses for \$35/day on USAC website but not on race site. Pre-registration will require an Annual or One-day license, both available onsite for race day registration.
