Course Description - 10 Mile out and back on CR 250 to the intersection of 250 and Trimble Lane

8am start for Collegiate TTT in following order: Women C, Women B, Men C/D, Men B, Women A, Men A

USAC categories will begin at 9am at 30 second intervals starting with Pro/Open Women, Cat 4/5(Novice) Men, 45+ Men, Pro/Open Men

10:30am-4:30pm – On-site Registration/Package Pickup for Criterium and Road Race (closes 15min before start) - Corner of 4th Ave./8th St.

- Collegiate Entry Fee- \$10 for TTT, \$35 each for Criterium/Road Race. USAC Collegiate license required. \$5 fee for race day reg!

- USAC Entry Fee- \$20 for ITT, \$40 each for Criterium/Road Race. \$5 fee for race day reg! **USAC License Required.** USAC 1-Day *Beginner* license: \$15, only for Cat 5 men Cat 5 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. Former USAC cat 1,2,3,4 members can purchase 1-day *Experience* licenses for \$35/day on USAC website but not on race site. Pre-registration will require an Annual or One-day license, both available onsite for race day registration.
