

2025 SCHEDULE OF FEES

Adopted January 6, 2025

MEMBERSHIPS

Colorado residents who hold a valid USA Cycling RACE membership are considered 'racing members' of Bicycle Colorado at no charge. This is a savings of \$40 over past years in which the local association charged a separate membership fee.

- Bicycle Colorado offers 'Advocacy Memberships' to support its work to make cycling safer and more accessible across the state. All racers are encouraged to join Bicycle Colorado in this manner.
- Officials Membership Officials need to join BC as an Advocacy Member for \$30 per year in order to be part of the BC Officials Program.
- <u>Bicycle Colorado Club Membership</u> are \$100 per year. Club Memberships are sold to both clubs of athletes and clubs of event directors, and are valid until December 31, 2025. Club memberships can be purchased through the BC website, or for event director clubs, will be included on post-event invoicing.

BICYCLE COLORADO EVENT SUPPORT PACKAGE FEES AND ACCESS TO RACE KIT

Definition: The Event Support Package Fee is a per rider / per day fee collected at all USAC-Sanctioned competitive events in the area for which the Bicycle Colorado serves as the Local Association of USAC. This Fee is determined by the Event Support Package that an event director chooses. There are two tiers (Basic and Premium) that come with different benefits as described in the document entitled 'Event Director Support for USAC Events."

Basic Support Package

Price: \$1.00 per unique racer

- Inclusion in season-long point Cup competitions
- Data validation for pre-registration
- Officials assignment and coordination
- Race radios for officials use
- Vehicle insurance coordinated and paid by Bicycle Colorado (# of certificates is based on race discipline)
- Ability to apply for State Championships designation

• Free use of RaceDayReg registration program, laptop and printer.

Premium Support Package includes Full Access to Race Kit

Price: \$2.00 per unique racer

- Inclusion in season-long point Cup competitions
- Data validation for pre-registration and final results
- Officials assignment and coordination
- Race radios for officials use
- Vehicle insurance coordinated and paid by Bicycle Colorado (# of certificates is based on race discipline)
- Ability to apply for State Championships designation
- Free use of RaceDayReg registration program, laptop and printer.
- Up to 15 rolls of CX course tape
- Race numbers and safety pins (one set of numbers 1-599 and one box of safety pins per permit)
- Full Access to Race Kit

The Race Kit includes most supplies needed to produce a local cycling event. Any loss or damage to Bicycle Colorado equipment will be charged to the Club/Event Director.

Race Bib Numbers

Bicycle Colorado offers bib numbers and pins to event directors. For event directors who choose the Basic Support package, pricing is \$.28 per number + USPS shipping (or available for pick up in Denver or Golden). Pins are \$10 per box.

BICYCLE COLORADO EVENT PROMOTION

Event Directors/Promoters may choose to pay for additional promotional support for their events with Bicycle Colorado. We have released a new tiered system of promotion options - please email Hilary for more information: <u>hilary@bicyclecolorado.org</u>.

USAC INSURANCE SURCHARGE

Please note that event directors are responsible for insurance surcharges and permit fees as per USAC regulations. These surcharges are determined by USAC and collected by all event directors based on the number of racers on race day. The 2025 rates are:

Standard Rate: \$5.99 per-rider / per-day

The total insurance surcharge will be a \$400 minimum or the per-rider fee, whichever is greater.

OFFICIALS FEES

Bicycle Colorado has established Minimum Officials Fees for USAC events in Colorado. These fees are based on the following chart, plus the cost of reasonable and necessary travel.

Full Day 4-8 hours Half Day 4 hours or less Overtime \$20 per hour in increments of 15 minutes

- The work day shall begin when the official arrives at the race site or one hour before the first race, whichever is later, and will end at the time when the required work is completed.
- The event director is responsible to provide housing and meals if an overnight stay is necessary before, during, or after the race.
- The event director must provide a meal and liquid refreshments for officials who work more than five hours during an event day. If meal(s) are not provided the event director shall pay an additional \$15.00 to each official. If an event director provides a meal, but an official brings his/her own meal due to a dietary restriction, the event director shall pay an additional \$10.00 to that official. For multiple day races, when an overnight stay is required, the event director shall pay each official a \$35 per diem.
- A Chief Referee may charge a fee of \$50.00 plus mileage for a site visit if the Chief Referee feels that such a visit is necessary. If an overnight stay is required, housing and a per diem of \$25 are required.
- In case a race is canceled after officials have begun their travel, officials will receive a half-day fee and their mileage.
- Mileage to and from the official's home and during the race will determine what is to be charged. Event directors shall also pay the maximum IRS business mileage rate to, during, and from the event and/or venue inspection. The current rate can be found at www.irs.gov
