EVENT CALENDAR

Ride The Rockies (June 9-15) This route is very unique to not only Ride The Rockies but Colorado, you will see parts of the state this tour has never been to and some amazing views. The roads are quiet and extremely well paved, the riding through Northwest Colorado is a hidden gem and sure to be challenging.

State TT Presented by It Could Be Me (June 22) The John Stenner Memorial Colorado State Time Trial Championships in Keenesburg features 10k, 20k, and 30k distances.

<u>Triple Bypass</u> (July 13) The legendary Triple Bypass is an epic bucket-list ride that stretches 118 miles, with 10,800 feet of elevation gain over 3 mountain passes: Juniper, Loveland, and Vail. The ride includes full support, stocked aid stations, and a finish party to celebrate.

Tour de Steamboat (July 13) The Tour de Steamboat is an annual bicycle event that brings together 1,200 cyclists for a one-day ride through beautiful Northwest Colorado. They host three different road ride routes—26, 46, and 66. They also host 2 gravel routes, a 100 mile, and a new 50 mile route.

<u>Colorado's Ride</u> (August 19-23) Colorado's Ride is a five-day road bike tour originating in Durango where you ride to Silverton and can take the historic train back. The next four days take you to Pagosa Springs and back to Durango with time to enjoy the hot springs after amazing rides.

<u>Buffalo Classic</u> (September 8) The Buffalo Bicycle Classic is a scholarship fundraiser for CU Boulder. The ride supports high-merit/high-financial-need scholarships for Colorado high school graduates to attend CU. There are 9 different routes and close Boulder Canyon for our Epic rides
